



# Medication at School

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Enclosed is the “Medication Authorization Form” issued to Seabury for students that require medication to be given at school. Please read the form carefully and complete it if needed. Please make sure that all medicine coming to school is labeled properly. All prescriptions must be in the original container with the child’s name on the label.

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If your child is on a regular medication dispensed only at home, please consider providing an “emergency supply” of required medication, as well as completing the Medication Authorization Form, to be kept in the school office. If your child requires an EpiPen be kept at school, please remember that it must be in the original prescription-labeled container and the Medication Authorization Form must be sent to school with the EpiPen.

All student medicine will be kept in the school office and administration will be supervised by a qualified person. Please be advised that Seabury School does not provide any medications to dispense to children.
