

Seabury School 2008/2009 Annual Report

Letter from the head of school.

The 2008-2009 school year was a turning point year for Seabury School in many ways. It was a year marked by both immense tragedy and immense promise for our school community. Most of all, it was a year in which the value of our community was in evidence as never before.

In August of 2008, Seabury's community was shaken by the news of the sudden and untimely death of our first grade teacher, Gregory Hampel, in a tragic car accident. A beloved teacher, parent, colleague and friend, Gregory began his teaching career at Seabury in 2003. He instilled in his students his passion for life, and his love of learning. Seabury students, staff and parents were stunned by his passing, but came together to support one another and Gregory's family during this difficult time. The value of being part of a small school community has never been felt as strongly as it was in the days and weeks after this tragedy. The kind of love and support that was shared during the course of the year is rare, and made many of us more grateful than ever that we can be part of the Seabury family.

The 2008-2009 school year was also a time of new challenges and opportunities for Seabury. During the previous school year, Seabury's Board of Trustees made the decision, after much study and discussion with parents and community leaders, to move forward with a plan to open a new, innovative middle school program. Plans called for the middle school program to be located at a satellite campus in downtown Tacoma. Recognizing that there was an unmet need in the community for a middle school program designed to meet the needs of highly capable students, and that downtown Tacoma offered a wealth of resources that could be utilized in a small middle school program designed to extend learning beyond classroom walls, planning for Seabury's new middle school program began during the 2008-2009 school year.

The economic downturn and resulting decline in enrollment made this commitment more challenging, but Seabury's trustees, parents and staff recognized that the growth and strength of the school as a whole was dependent upon offering a strong middle school program. And so, in spite of the challenges, planning for the middle school moved forward. By the end of the 2008-2009 school year, space for the program was secured in the Knights of Pythias building, located in the heart of Tacoma's theater district. Students were enrolled for 6th and 7th grade, with plans to add 8th grade during the 2010-2011 school year. Curriculum was developed, community partnerships in place, and plans were set for the opening of the middle school campus in the fall of 2009. Even during the 2008-2009 school year, Seabury's addition of middle school had a positive impact on enrollment for the school as a whole, and enabled Seabury to get through a difficult economic time without cutting programs or services for students in any grade level.

As Seabury looks forward, our school finds itself on the brink of an exciting future. Though on two campuses, Seabury remains one school, committed to serving students in our community who have the potential to be our next generation of leaders, innovators and creators. A school that offers children who love to learn the opportunity to think deeply, to explore more fully, and to immerse themselves in new ideas and understandings. A community of learners who support each other in times of both celebration and sadness. There is much to look forward to at Seabury. And we are grateful to all who, in ways large and small, make it possible for us to do the work we do with and for our amazing children. Thank you for being part of the Seabury family and supporting our efforts in 2008-2009.

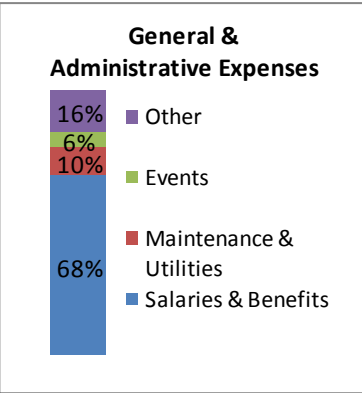
Educational Expenses
